FOLLOWING JESUS: BIBLE JOURNAL FOR KIDS

God's Word tells us that the way we become a follower of Jesus is to trust in Him and repent from our sin (Romans 10:9-10.) *After* we trust in Jesus, we take the next step of being baptized. Baptism is *not* what saves us, but it is an act of obedience to Jesus and shows others the choice that we've made to follow Him.

BUT ONCE WE'RE BAPTIZED, WHAT DO WE DO NEXT?

The Bible tells us that God's Word is a lamp to our feet and a light to our path (Psalm 119). As a Christ follower, it is important to read and learn from God's Word. It helps lead, guide, and direct us in the way that we should live.

Use this 4 step guide to not only read the bible, but try to understand it and apply it to your life.

READ:

Find the big idea of the passage and explain in your own words.

APPLY:

Apply the passage to your life. How is the bible asking you to live?

PRAY:



"Then the Lord said, "I have surely seen the affliction of my people who are in Egypt and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters. I know their sufferings, and I have come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land to a good and broad land, a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Amorites, the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites." "And Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, "Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor. And if I have defrauded anyone of anything, I restore it fourfold." And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, since he also is a son of Abraham. For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." Luke 19:8-10
