In order to go on this trip, your student must be 16 years of age.

What will my student be doing on this trip?

While in London, your student will be partnering with an organization called UK-USA ministries. This organization is focused in the Teas Valley. Your student will be coming alongside churches in England in their outreach ministries to schools and sports clubs. They will have the opportunity to make relationships with kids, share the gospel and be the hands and feet as they meet tangible needs in the community.

Will my student need a passport?

Does my student need any vaccinations?

Yes, your student will need: hepatitis A, hepatitis B, rabies, meningitis, polio, measles, mumps and rubella (MMR), Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis), chickenpox, shingles, pneumonia and influenza. No covid vaccine is needed at this time.
