- Be effective to recruit, train, motivate and empower volunteers in worship and implement strategic plans for worship
- Ensure ongoing leadership training for worship team members
- Actively recruit to fill leadership positions in the worship ministry
- Participate in weekly central worship meetings
- Attend monthly worship service planning with the Central Worship Pastor and Lead Pastor
- Leadership in Biltmore Worship Songwriting Initiative
- Occasionally lead worship at other Biltmore Church venues such at Western Carolina University, Vertical, ONE, etc.
- Responsible for attending West Asheville team meetings
- Work closely with West Asheville staff team to accomplish overall action plans (Goals and Action Plan)
- Assist in assimilating new members into the West Asheville Campus
- Contact first time visitors in a timely manner as assigned by the West Asheville Campus Pastor
- Perform other duties assigned by Central Worship Pastor and West Asheville Campus Pastor
