- Assist Central Student Pastor in planning, promoting, implementing, and leading major student events throughout the year including Wake Weekend, Camp Week, etc.
- Develop a healthy relationship with parents of students and provide resources on a consistent basis
- Plan and provide activities and outings for students outside of regular student programming
- Follow up with first time families and help new students get assimilated into the Student Ministry
- Assist in recruiting students for mission trips and leading the trips as asked by the Central Student Pastor
- Recruit, train, motivate, and evaluate student ministry volunteers
- Spend time building relationships with students by attending sporting events, plays, band recitals, etc.
- Develop and maintain a healthy relationship with the local schools
- Provide consistent weekly communication to families utilizing platforms approved by student ministry.
