PRAYER GUIDE

JUNE 2023

INTRODUCTION:

Thanks for being part of our prayer team! We believe God will move in and through Biltmore Church in huge ways in 2023. God calls His people to pray and promises to answer those prayers. This month is packed as we will celebrate Father's Day, continue our study of the Psalms, and have Adventure Week! Let's pray that the hearts of the people in our church will be changed through the preaching of God's Word and that the Holy Spirit will use our efforts to make Adventure Week a fun environment for children to hear the Gospel.

PREPARING TO PRAY:

God hears our prayers, and He cares for us. As Christ-followers, we approach God our Father through Jesus Christ, His Son. In Matthew 6, Jesus gives us clear instruction. Prayer is about spending time with our Father, trusting in Him, acknowledging His greatness and our need for Him, focusing our thoughts, and glorifying our Father as we pray before going through specific, targeted prayer requests.

HOW TO PRAY:

Confession:

This means admitting and agreeing with God about the sin in our lives, confessing it, and turning away from all things that dishonor God. "I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord," and you forgave the iniquity of my sin." Psalm 32:5

Adoration:

This means worshiping, recognizing, and acknowledging God for who He is. "Let everything that has breath praise the Lord!" Psalm 150:6

Thanksgiving:

This means gratefulness, spending time with God, and thanking Him for all He has done. "Oh give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever!" Psalm 107:1

Supplication:

This is when we make requests to God on behalf of others, praying for God's will in the lives of family, friends, people in our sphere of influence, and around the world. "Give ear, O Lord, to my prayer; listen to my plea for grace." Psalm 86:6

Prayer for Our Community:

Lord, we thank you for placing us in Western North Carolina. Nothing you do is an accident, so we know we are here for a purpose. We pray that you would work through us as we serve our community this month. We ask that you would help us to identify and meet needs. We pray that you would be glorified through our efforts.

REACH UP
