Vision:

Join us as we serve alongside missionaries on the field in New York to share the gospel with Mideast/North African Muslims during their shifting week. Shifting week is a week focused on shifting the community for the glory of God through evangelism. With this focus on evangelism, we hope you'll join in the effort to reach people and places where God is not known.

We believe that one day people from every tribe, tongue, and nation will worship God around His throne. With close to 8 million people in New York City, and more than 22 million in the metro area, it is the largest city in the United States. It is also the largest metro area in the world and is considered by many to be the most influential city in the world. It is estimated that 36% of the population is foreign-born, resulting in varied cultural and religious backgrounds. Though 83% of New Yorkers are affiliated with some form of organized religion, only 4% identify themselves as evangelical.

What's Expected:

As a team member joining missionaries in New York, you will be an extension of their presence in the community. You will be helping them establish relationships and have Gospel conversations with families and children of the surrounding communities. Other expectations include:

- **Honoring** - The way you interact with people that are not like you will directly impact their view of Jesus. You must be mindful of the things you say, the way you interact and the way you show honor, in order to not create any barriers of the Gospel being heard.

- Maintain flexibility Scheduled activities are subject to change due to various factors so maintaining a spirit of flexibility allows you to be open to any changes God may have for your team.
- Care Serving on a short-term mission trip is a great way to serve and care for our long-term missionaries. Offering to cook a meal, watching their children so they can go out, cleaning, game nights, etc., are all great ways to care for our missionaries on the field.
- **Show Up** Be present for all pre-trip and post-trip meetings as well as all in-country activities. We want you to make the most of your time as you engage the nations with the hope of the gospel.

Requirements

- Attends connect group on a regular basis (50%)
- Must complete kids ministry training if kids ministry is involved.
- Must be able to articulate the Gospel
- Interview with a student pastor

- Preparation

- Abide by the Mission Trip Fundraising Guide
- Attend 75% of the trainings
- Follow along with the mission booklet

Steps to Apply:

- Your student pastor will reach out to set up a time for an interview with them and your small group leader.
- After the interview, the student pastor will reach out to you to let you know if you have been approved.
- To solidify your spot, you will need to pay a nonrefundable deposit of \$150 for a national or \$300 for an international deposit on your Biltmore profile.
