Join us in Brooklyn, New York as we partner with Park Slope Community Church in their mission to be a church that cultivates deep roots in Christ and demonstrates active love for their neighbors. This team will focus on helping renew a 150 year old church building that Park Slope Community Church calls home through demolition work, a stairwell repair, and prayer walking in their community.

We believe that one day people from every tribe, tongue, and nation will worship God around His throne. New York is a cultural melting pot where many tribes, tongues, and nations relocate to. It is home to people from Asia, South America, Europe, and several more. In this state alone, we get to see part of this picture of every tribe, nation, and tongue. As we share the Gospel, we hope to see the picture of Revelation 7:9 slowly become complete.

What's Expected:

As a team member joining in on the ministry happening through Park Slope Community Church in New York, you will play an integral part of the ministry happening in our home country. The Park Slope team has developed strategic opportunities that Biltmore Church gets to engage in with a focus on construction, prayer walking/evangelism, care and support for the staff and members, and exposure to a city with deep roots of culture. Other expectations include:

- **Evangelism / Prayer Walking** - you will have the opportunity to share the Gospel with locals.

- **Maintain flexibility** - Scheduled activities are subject to change due to various factors so maintaining a spirit of flexibility allows you to be open to any changes God may have for your team.
- **Care** - serving on a short-term mission trip is a great way to serve and care for the team leading Redeemer Queens Park. Offering to cook a meal, watching their children so they can go out, cleaning, game nights, etc., are all great ways to care for our partners on the field.
- **Show Up** - Be present for all pre-trip and post-trip meetings as well as all in-country activities. We want you to make the most of your time as you engage the nations with the hope of the gospel.

Requirements

- **Prerequisites**
 - Must have a valid driver's license or other form of identification for travel.

 - Must be able to lift 40 pounds.
 - Must complete kids ministry training if kids ministry is involved.
 - Must complete a background check.
- **Responsibilities**
 - Carry yourself at all times as a disciple of Jesus Christ.
 - Engage with people from other cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds.
 - Comfortability initiating and facilitating spiritual conversations.
 - Commitment to hearing from God through his Word on your decision to go on this trip.
 - Fundraising - It is your responsibility to fundraise the total amount required for your trip.
