Vision:

Join us as we serve alongside Mission City Church in Jacksonville, Florida. During our trip, we will be partnering in the work that Mission City Church is doing in the community through kids ministry, evangelism and encouraging their long-term partners.

One of our desires as a church is to reach our local community, our nation, and the world with the hope of the Gospel. We believe God has called us to be faithful witnesses both near and far—to love our neighbors, serve our cities, and go to the nations. One way we live this out is by serving within our own country and partnering with churches in other states. As we serve in Jacksonville, Florida, we hope to come alongside Mission City Church—to lift their hands, encourage their ministry, and help them make a lasting impact in their community for the glory of God.

What's Expected:

As a team member joining this church plant in Jacksonville, you will be an extension of their presence in the community. You will be helping them establish relationships and have Gospel conversations with families and children of the surrounding communities. Other expectations include:

Honoring - The way you interact with people that are not like you will directly
impact their view of Jesus. You must be mindful of the things you say, the way
you interact and the way you show honor, in order to not create any barriers of
the Gospel being heard.

- Maintain flexibility Scheduled activities are subject to change due to various factors so maintaining a spirit of flexibility allows you to be open to any changes God may have for your team.
- Care Serving on a short-term mission trip is a great way to serve and care for our long-term missionaries. Offering to cook a meal, watching their children so they can go out, cleaning, game nights, etc., are all great ways to care for our missionaries on the field.
- Show Up Be present for all pre-trip and post-trip meetings as well as all in-country activities. We want you to make the most of your time as you engage the nations with the hope of the gospel.

- Interview with a student pastor

- Abide by the Mission Trip Fundraising Guide
- Attend 75% of the trainings
- Follow along with the mission booklet

- After the interview, the student pastor will reach out to you to let you know if you have been approved.
- To solidify your spot, you will need to pay a nonrefundable deposit of \$150 for a national or \$300 for an international deposit on your Biltmore profile.
