## <u>Vision</u>:

Join us in serving alongside local churches in Middlesbrough, England. This trip will include opportunities to share the Gospel through evangelism, participate in compassion ministries, and engage with students in schools. In a postmodern culture where many see Jesus only as a historical figure, we will place a strong emphasis on apologetics—offering clear and thoughtful answers to help others see the truth of the Gospel.

We believe that one day, people from every tribe, tongue, and nation will worship God around His throne. England is considered a postmodern society, meaning that the majority of people will never step inside a Christian church and will never hear the true Gospel. As we minister among this community, our prayer is that the gospel would be made known among this people group and spread throughout this city to multiply and strengthen local disciple-making movements.

## **What's Expected:**

As a team member joining the church plant in Middlesbrough, you will be an extension of their presence in the community. You will be helping them establish relationships and have Gospel conversations with families and children of the surrounding communities. Other expectations include:

- **Honoring** - The way you interact with people who are not like you will directly impact their view of Jesus. You must be mindful of the things you say, the way you interact, and the way you show honor, in order to not create any barriers to the Gospel being heard.

- Maintain flexibility Scheduled activities are subject to change due to various factors so maintaining a spirit of flexibility allows you to be open to any changes God may have for your team.
- Care Serving on a short-term mission trip is a great way to serve and care for our long-term missionaries. Offering to cook a meal, watching their children so they can go out, cleaning, game nights, etc., are all great ways to care for our missionaries on the field.
- Show Up Be present for all pre-trip and post-trip meetings as well as all in-country activities. We want you to make the most of your time as you engage the nations with the hope of the gospel.

# **Requirements**

## - Prerequisites

- Rising 9th graders- graduated 12th graders
- Attends connect group on a regular basis (50%)
- Must complete kids ministry training if kids ministry is involved.
- Must be able to articulate the Gospel
- Interview with a student pastor

#### - Preparation

- Abide by the Mission Trip Fundraising Guide
- Attend 75% of the trainings
- Follow along with the mission booklet

## Visa / Passport (International)

- Must have a valid passport with at least six months of validity remaining when traveling internationally. Visit <u>travel.state.gov</u> for more information on applying for a passport.
- A visa is required for entry into the country\_and is covered by your trip cost. The cost is \$25, which will be paid online when applying.

# Steps to Apply:

- You fill out the application at <u>Biltmorechurch.com/missions</u>
- Your student pastor will reach out to set up a time for an interview with them and your small group leader.
- After the interview, the student pastor will reach out to you to let you know if you have been approved.
- To solidify your spot, you will need to pay a nonrefundable deposit of \$150 for a national or \$300 for an international deposit on your Biltmore profile.
